

1. In fifth grade there are 64 boys and 59 girls. How many students are there in fifth grade?

2. The fish in the aquarium are disappearing! On Thursday there were 17 fish in the aquarium. On Monday there were 9 fish in the aquarium. How many fish have disappeared from the aquarium?

3. Mr. Potter made a batch of 73 brownies. His wife ate 12 brownies, and his daughter ate 25 brownies. How many brownies does Mr. Potter have left?

4. There are 123 fifth graders at Lockhart Elementary. There are 112 fourth graders. There are 115 third graders. How many more third and fourth graders are there than fifth graders?

5. In 5th grade, 80 students like dogs better than cats. The other fifth graders like cats more than dogs. There are 123 total fifth graders. How many students like cats more than dogs?

6. Chip sends a lot of texts. On Monday he sent 45 texts. On Tuesday he sent 74 texts. On Wednesday he sent some more texts. Chip sent 200 total texts from Monday to Wednesday. How many texts did Chip send on Wednesday?

7. In total Mr. Potter's class did 376 word problems for homework on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday. They did 100 on Wednesday and 150 on Thursday. How many word problems did they do on Friday?
