

Writing Station:

Pick one of the writing prompts below, and begin writing a story. You should spend your entire time at this station writing as much as you can. There is no being 'finished'. If you finish a story, then start improving on it, editing it, changing it. If you feel satisfied with a story, then start a new one.

Imagine your school closes for the day, and you can do anything you want. What will you do? Write a story about what happens.

What is one item you would like to have? Write to describe the item and explain why you want it. What would you do with it once you got it?

There is a saying that time goes by quickly when you are having fun. Write about an exciting event in which the time seemed to go by faster than usual.

Imagine yourself as a superhero. You might be able to see through walls, fly, or swim like a fish. Write about your superhuman power and what happens when you use it.

Imagine you and a friend found a spaceship. The door opened and you looked inside. Write about what happened.

Imagine one day at school you are allowed to create a rule for students to follow. Explain the rule you create and why you choose to make that rule. Be sure to include details.
