Dividing Fractions

$$1) \quad \frac{3}{4} \div \frac{1}{10} = \frac{3 \times 10}{4 \times 1} = \frac{30}{4} = \frac{15}{2} = 7\frac{1}{2}$$

$$2) \quad \frac{6}{9} \div \frac{4}{5} = \frac{6 \times 5}{9 \times 4} = \frac{30}{36} = \frac{5}{6}$$

$$3) \quad \frac{3}{5} \div \frac{2}{4} = \frac{3 \times 4}{5 \times 2} = \frac{12}{10} = \frac{6}{5} = 1\frac{1}{5}$$

$$4) \quad \frac{2}{3} \div \frac{3}{4} = \frac{2 \times 4}{3 \times 3} = \frac{8}{9}$$

$$5) \quad \frac{9}{10} \div \frac{3}{7} = \frac{9 \times 7}{10 \times 3} = \frac{63}{30} = \frac{21}{10} = 2\frac{1}{10}$$

$$6) \quad \frac{1}{2} \div \frac{2}{3} = \frac{1 \times 3}{2 \times 2} = \frac{3}{4}$$

$$7) \quad \frac{5}{8} \div \frac{1}{3} = \frac{5 \times 3}{8 \times 1} = \frac{15}{8} = 1\frac{7}{8}$$

$$8) \quad \frac{5}{6} \div \frac{1}{7} = \frac{5 \times 7}{6 \times 1} = \frac{35}{6} = 5\frac{5}{6}$$

$$9) \quad \frac{1}{4} \div \frac{4}{6} = \frac{1 \times 6}{4 \times 4} = \frac{6}{16} = \frac{3}{8}$$

$$10) \quad \frac{6}{10} \div \frac{5}{7} = \frac{6 \times 7}{10 \times 5} = \frac{42}{50} = \frac{21}{25}$$
